- Daily health screenings for participants and staff (provided below)
- Supervised hand sanitizing and frequent hand washing
- Limiting the number of participants in each group
- Maintaining physical distancing protocols, including at check-in and check-out
- Cleaning and sanitizing facilities multiple times each day
- Cleaning and sanitizing all high-touch areas frequently
- Requiring face coverings for participants and staff

Should it be necessary for my child to have medical treatment while participating in this trip, I hereby give the responsible personnel or chaperones permission to use their judgment in obtaining medical service, and I give permission to the physician selected by the school personnel or chaperone to render medical treatment deemed necessary and appropriate by the physician.
