GRADE 4

The following supplies will be needed when school opens:

1. Student Planner- Assignment Book - purchase at registration
2. 1 package WIDE RULED paper
3. 4 One-Subject notebooks with 70 pages (no dividers) - labeled - D.O.L., Religion, Reading, Science
4 One-Subject notebooks with 140 pages (no dividers) – labeled Math, Social Studies, English, Novels
4. 1 Pee-Chee folders - labeled “Homework”
5. 3x5 index cards – ruled (optional)
6. 2 yellow highlighters
7. 2 sturdy, strong zipper cases
8. Scissors - labeled
9. 24 # 2 pencils - labeled & sharpened – MUST REPLENISH AS NEEDED.
10. 2 dry erase markers -black
11. 5 black eraser pens
12. 6 red ball point pens - no clicker/retractable type pens!
13. 1 box Crayola Classic markers (10 or 12 count)
14. 1 pkg. of Twist-up crayons (24 count)
15. 1 ruler with centimeters and inches
16. 2 glue sticks
17. 1 bottle of white liquid glue - small 2 or 4 oz. only!
