

## 2011-2012 Supply List Grade 5

Students are strongly encouraged to continue to use supplies from fourth grade that are in good condition (e.g. ruler, crayons, etc). The following supplies will be needed when school opens:

Students will be given a container to store supplies on his or her desk. Please label everything; especially the expo markers because they are easily confused. Replenish supplies as necessary.

- 6 red ball point pens (not erasable)
- 10 blue or black ball point pens (not erasable, not clicker type)
- 25 sharpened # 2 pencils
- 2 pink erasers
- thick yellow highlighter
- 8 black Expo dry erase markers (wide chiseled tip)
- 1 old washcloth or white board eraser

Please purchase 1 hard plastic pencil box for art supplies. The box should be big enough to store the following supplies and small enough to fit in the desk. The following should be kept in the box at all times:

- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 glue stick (keep 2 extra at home)
- 24 pack of crayons
- 8 Crayola Thick Markers
- 8 Crayola Thin Markers
- Small box of colored pencils (8 to 12 pack)
- Oil Pastels

Other items that will be kept in the desk daily

- 1 ½ white binder (slide paper in front)
- 5 pack of dividers – labeled (Religion, Math, Reading, Language, Social Studies,)
- Student Planner “Good News Assignment Book “ purchase at registration on August 10
- Clear plastic 12” ruler with inches and centimeters
- 3-Five subject notebooks with pockets in dividers (one for each trimester)  
(Bring one on the first day of school.)

The following items will be collected on the first day:

- 2 packages of wide ruled paper (1 for school, 1 for home)
- 2 large box of tissues
- 2 container of baby wipes
- 4 report folders (2 pocket folder with prongs) (2 red and 2 blue)
- 2-Blue pocket folders
- 2-Red pocket report folders

Other:

- Three packages, 3 X 5 in. 100 count ruled index cards (lines on 1 side, blank on the other)
- Index card case (holds 100 3 X 5” cards)
- 5 Large or jumbo book socks

Children must have their own supplies. They may not borrow from other students. A book bag must be used every day to bring items to and from school. Please make sure that all of the above items are well labeled with your child’s name, as well as lunch boxes, sweaters, book bags and anything that might misplaced.
